Punishment for second and subsequent offences.

278A. If any person convicted of an offence under <u>section 276B</u> or sub-section (1) of <u>section 276C</u> or <u>section 276CC</u> or <u>section 276DD</u> or <u>section 276E</u> or <u>section 277</u> or <u>section 278</u> is again convicted of an offence under any of the aforesaid provisions, he shall be punishable for the second and for every subsequent offence with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than six months but which may extend to seven years and with fine.
